


What do our students need to succeed in a global workforce?



- Knowledge of and experience with the world's peoples and places
- Cross-cultural competence in understanding diverse practices and perspectives
- Specialized and advanced language proficiency





- Georgia was the 19th state to pass legislation supporting the Seal
- Certifies advanced literacy in English and a second language
- Testing available in over 100 languages
- 2020-2021 school year: 2,579 seals in 72 districts in 23 languages
- Currently 45 states support the Seal









Georgia's International Skills Diploma Seal (ISDS)


- Established in May 2015
- High school students with an international education curriculum
 - Requires **community service** and a capstone presentation
 - Over 110 participating high schools
- ISDS STAR students receive awards for best **Capstone** presentation
 - Over 5,000 seals have been awarded to Georgia students
